

# Empowerment-Workshop for people who have experienced racism 12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> of July 2024

This workshop is exclusively for Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPoC)/"non-*white*" people.

People who are exposed to racism often do not have safe spaces where they can talk about their experiences. The situation is particularly difficult for Black Indigenous and People of Color (BIPoC) who are involved with education or development cooperation. They often have to find a balance between the interests of the organizations, solidarity and their own concerns.

This workshop intends to provide a protected and safe space in which participants can share their personal experiences. In addition to dealing with the system of racism and the aftermath of a colonial order, along with the internal impact of racism and discrimination, the participants will develop strategies to handle all this and learn how to strengthen themselves.

The methods are based among other things on the anti-biasapproach, which tackles various forms of discrimination and intersectionality (multiple discrimination).

The workshop will be held in English.
