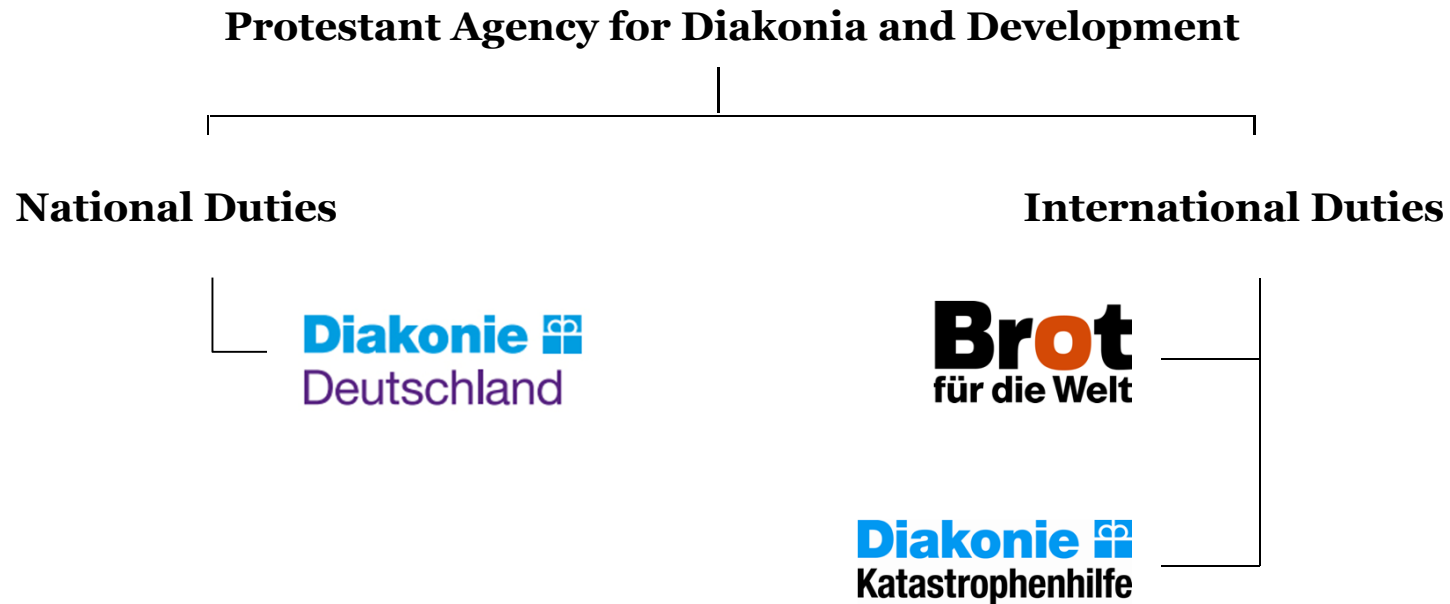
Who we are

- In Germany we fund about 500 development related educational projects.

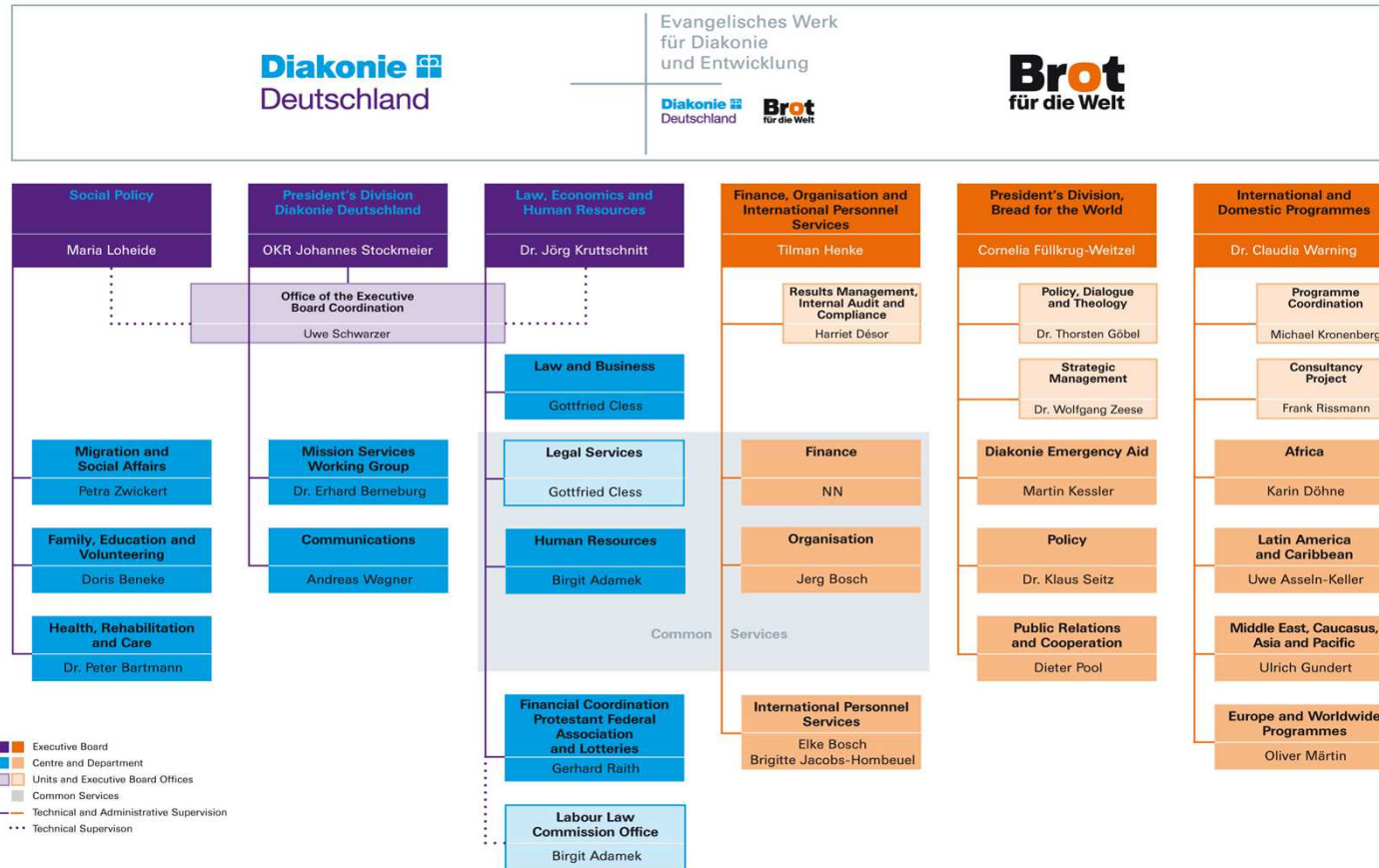

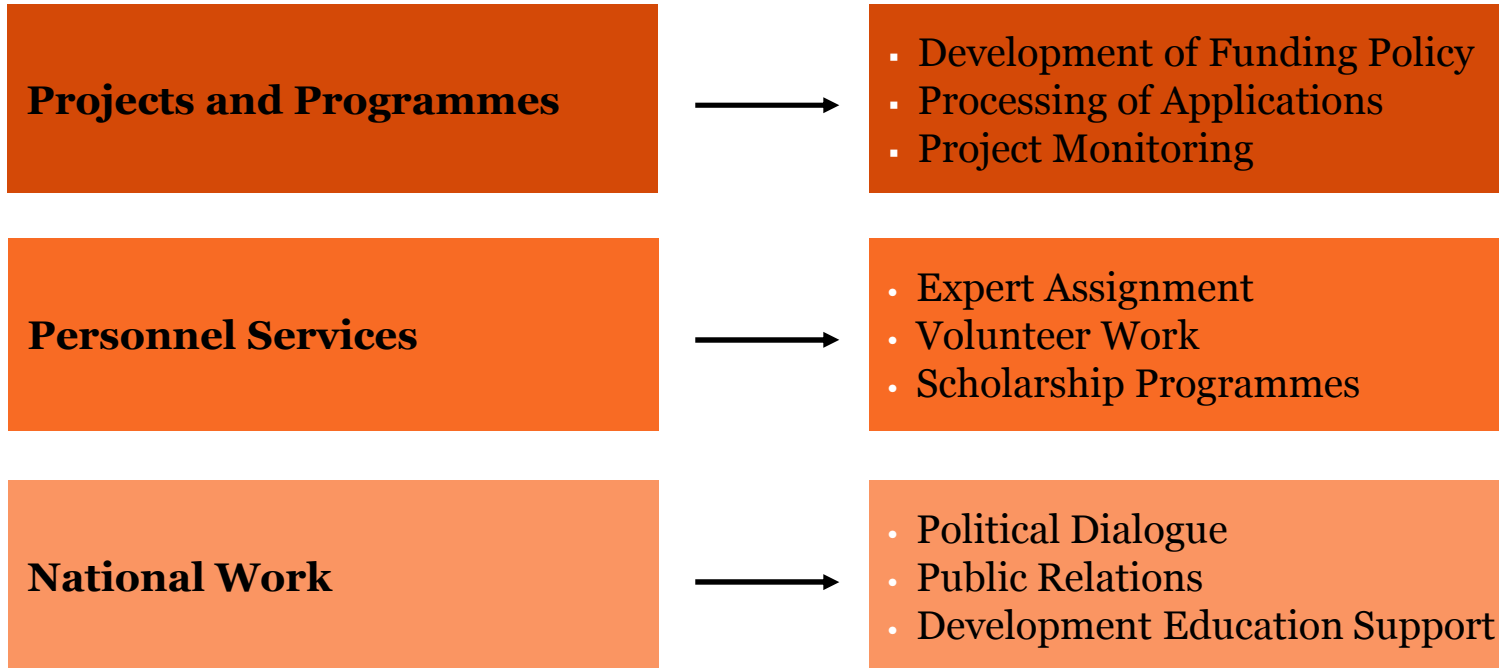

International level

- **Global Coalition for Social Protection floors**
 - 59 member organisations
 - influencing policies at UN level
 - promoting and discussing ILO SPF
- **ACT Alliance - Action by Churches Together**
 - 160 members worldwide, working in 140 countries
 - humanitarian aid, development, advocacy
 - community of practice social protection?
- **EU working group on decent work and social protection in development co-operation**
 - SOLIDAR, Light for the World, Stop AIDS Alliance, World Solidarity, HelpAge, Church of Sweden
 - policy dialogue and lobby work at EU level

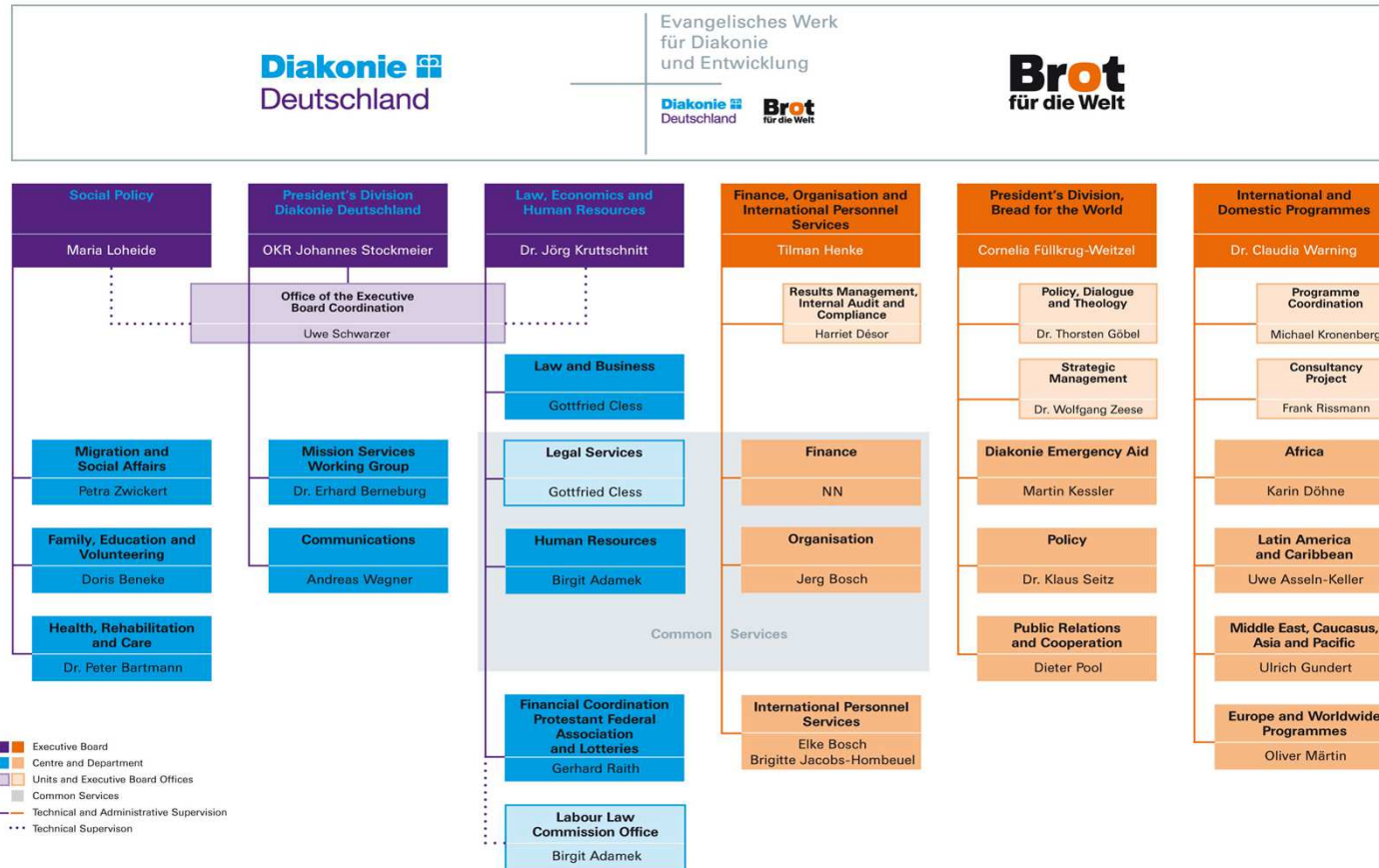
National level



- **VENRO (German NGO-network) working group on social protection**
 - 20 member organisations
 - started in 2013
 - common voice
- **Political Dialogue with BMZ** (Ministry for Development Co-operation) and **GIZ** (German Society for international Co-operation)
- Lobby work with **Members of Parliament**
- **Diakonie Germany**
 - Social Welfare Organization of Germany's Protestant Churches
 - merger in 2012 – joint lobby work

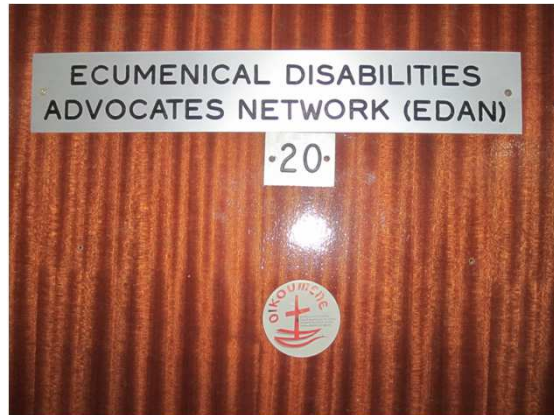

Principles

- Cooperation with local partner organisations
 - Project partners are
 - Churches
 - Church-related organisations
 - Non-governmental organisations
 - Promotion according to the principle of helping people to help themselves
- Assistance independent from caste, creed, religion or sex

- support marginalised people and people living in poverty to improve their living conditions
- contribute to create the political and economical prerequisites for overcoming poverty
- support political and rights education
- promote and support networking and exchange
- facilitate action based research
- support and facilitate peer-to-peer-learning

Projects and Programmes

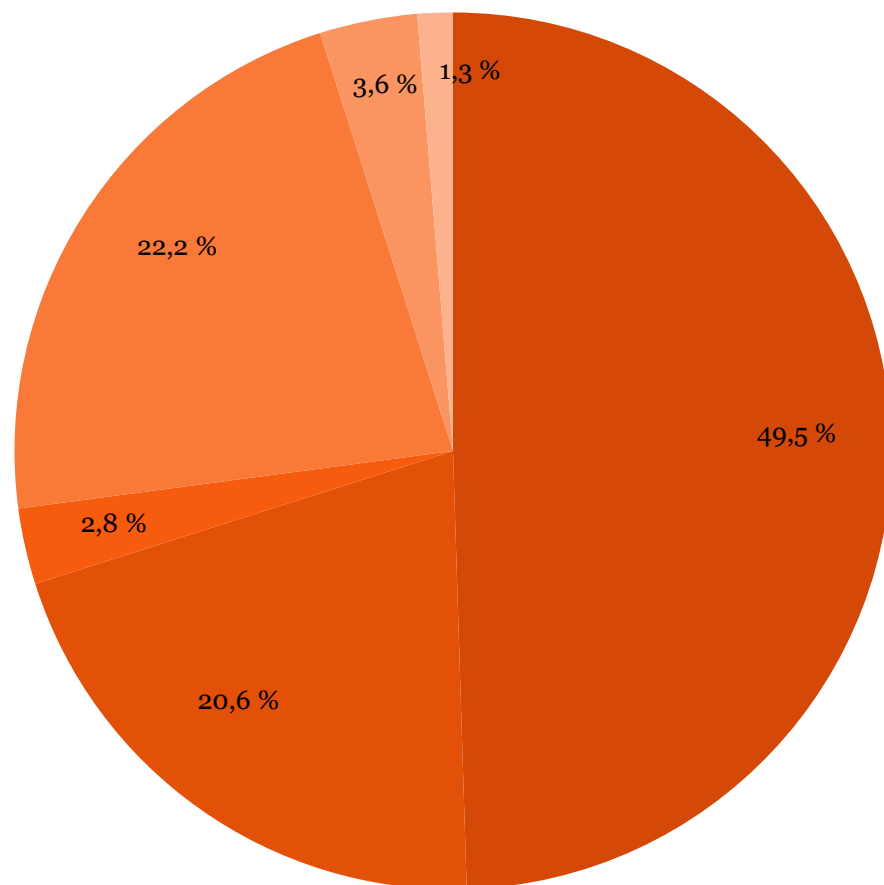
Consultancy Services

Source of Funds in 2012

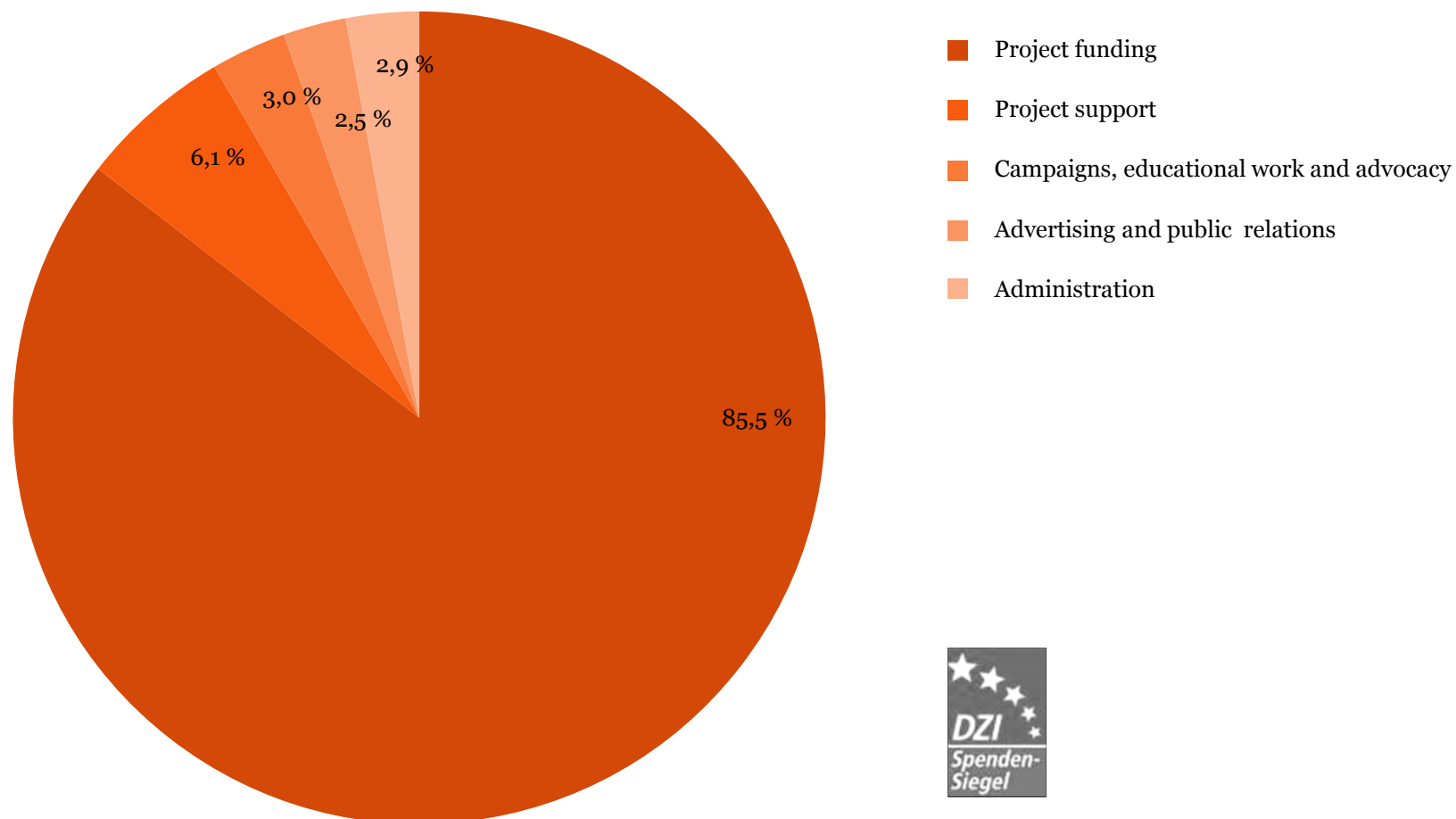


- Public funds
