- In Germany we fund about 500 development related educational projects.




Bread for the World – Protestant Development Service Organigram

- Lobby work with Members of Parliament



Social Security Co-operation with Partners






- Cooperation with local partner organisations

- support and facilitate peer-to-peer-learning


Projects and Programmes Consultancy Services

 - Implementation of seminars and trainings




