Hello, my name is Ogunjumelo Boluwatife, a current member of Brot für die Welt Jugend and I was born and raised in Lagos, Nigeria. Today, I would like to share with you the challenges my city faces with land use and rights, focusing on a recent event that affected many lives.

The Demolition of Tarkwa Bay

In January 2020, the government demolished homes and businesses at Tarkwa Bay, a beloved beach community in Lagos. They said it was to stop illegal activities, but for the residents, it meant losing their homes and livelihoods with little warning. Imagine waking up to bulldozers ready to tear down your house – this is the harsh reality for many Lagosians.
